

The Minor Prophets: **Micah (Part 2)**

**Key Passage**

*Micah 7:18-20*

*18 Who is a God like you, pardoning iniquity and passing over transgression for the remnant of his inheritance?*

*He does not retain his anger forever, because he delights in steadfast love.*

*19 He will again have compassion on us; he will tread our iniquities underfoot. You will cast all our sins into the depths of the sea.*

*20 You will show faithfulness to Jacob and steadfast love to Abraham, as you have sworn to our fathers from the days of old.*

- 4) What can we take away?
  
- 5) If you only had the first half of Micah, how would you share the gospel with someone who doesn't know Christ?

**Questions to think about:**

- 1) In one sentence: What is the second half of Micah about?
  
- 2) What makes the case God makes against the people of Israel through Micah unique? Why is this significant?
  
- 3) According to Micah, what action does God take with His people's sin? (cf. *Deut. 30:6; Ps. 103:12; Isa. 38:17; Jer. 50:20; Ezek. 11:19 and 36:25; Hosea 14:4; Rom. 6:18 and 8:2*)
  
- 4) A big emphasis in Micah is justice. How should Christians promote justice? How does doing justice, loving mercy, and walking humbly fit together? Do they need to fit together?
  
- 4) If you only had the first half of Micah, how would you share the gospel with someone who doesn't know Christ?
