- 2. Love may come disguised as love for another but the relationship is to support the love of self.
- 3. The church and its leaders can be led astray as put in Luke 16:14; Philippians 2:21 Paul gets tp the heart of the matter 2 Tim. 3:4
- 4. Lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God "without a love of good"; describing someone who is hostile to the things of God. 2 Peter 3:3
- 5. Having a form of godliness, but denying its power.

"The relation of the form of godliness to the men who make the grievous times, is that it conceals their true character. It is self throughout, in a more or less hateful form, and therefore the real power of godliness is denied. But it does not appear so nakedly and hatefully to be self where there is a form of acknowledging God. The relation of the form of godliness to the grievous times is, that it allows evil to work more insidiously. It is not so difficult to meet pure heathenism as it is to meet a Christianity that has become heathenish." Thomas Croskery D.D, Commentary on 2 Timothy 3 Find him here:
