Reflection Before the Service

"The greatest barrier I have met is the almost total absence from the minds of my audience of any sense of sin... The early Christian preachers could assume in their hearers,...a sense of guilt...Thus the Christian message was in those days unmistakably the Evangelium, the Good News. It promised healing to those who knew they were sick. We have to convince our hearers of the unwelcome diagnosis before we can expect them to welcome the news of the remedy.

The ancient man approached God (or even the gods) as the accused person approaches his judge.

For the modern man, the roles are quite reversed. He is the judge: God is in the dock (being judged). He (man) is quite a kindly judge; if God should have a reasonable defense for being the god who permits war, poverty, and disease, he is ready to listen to it. The trial may even end in God's acquittal. But the important thing is that man is on the bench and God is in the dock."

John 5:18, 30-46

¹⁸ This was why the Jews were seeking all the more to kill him, because not only was he breaking the **Sabbath**, but he was even **calling God his own Father, making himself equal with God.**

³⁰"I can do nothing on my own. <u>As I hear, I judge, & my judgment is</u> just, because I seek not my own will but the will of him who sent me.

- ³¹ <u>If I alone *bear witness*</u> about myself, my testimony is not true.
 ³² There is another who *bears witness* about me, and I know that the testimony that he bears about me is true.
- (1) ³³ You sent to John, and he has <u>borne witness</u> to the truth.
 ³⁴ Not that the testimony that I receive is from man, but I say these things so that you may be saved. ³⁵He was a burning and shining lamp, & you were willing to rejoice for a while in his light. ³⁶But the testimony that I have is greater than that of John.
- (2) <u>For the works</u> that the Father has given me to accomplish, the very works that I am doing, <u>bear witness</u> about me that the Father has sent me.
- (3) ³⁷ And the Father who sent me has himself *borne witness* about me. His voice you have never heard, his form you have never seen, ³⁸ and you do not have his word abiding in you, for YOU DO NOT BELIEVE the one whom he has sent.
- (4) ³⁹ You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; & it is they that <u>bear witness</u> about me, ⁴⁰yet you refuse to come to me that you may have life.

⁴¹ I do not receive glory from people. ⁴² But <u>I know</u> that <u>you do not</u> <u>have the love of God</u> within you. ⁴³ I have come in my Father's name, and <u>YOU DO NOT RECEIVE ME</u>. If another comes in his own name, you will receive him. ⁴⁴ How can you **believe**, when <u>YOU RECEIVE</u> <u>GLORY FROM ONE ANOTHER</u> and do not seek the glory that comes from the only God?

⁴⁵ Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father. There is one who accuses you: Moses, on whom you have set your hope. ⁴⁶ For if you **believed** Moses, you would **believe** me; **for he wrote of me.** ⁴⁷ But if you do not **believe** his writings, how will you **believe** my words?"
