Isaiah 11:1-10

- ¹There shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, (Is. 3:2-3) and a branch from his roots shall bear fruit. (Zech. 4:10, 5:12)
- ² And the <u>Spirit of the LORD</u> shall rest upon him, (Matt 1:18, 3:16) the Spirit of <u>wisdom</u> and <u>understanding</u>, (1 Kings 3) the Spirit of <u>counsel</u> and <u>might</u>, (Is. 61:1) the Spirit of <u>knowledge</u> and the <u>fear of the LORD</u>. (2 Sam 23:2-3) (The Seven Spirits Rev 1:4, 3:1, 4:5, 5:6)
- ³ And **his delight** shall be <u>in the fear of the LORD</u>. (Ps 37:4, Jn. 4:33) He shall not **judge** by what his eyes see, (Jn. 8:14-18,26) or decide disputes by what his ears hear, (Jn. 12:47-48) ⁴ but with **righteousness** he shall judge the poor, (Jn. 7:24), (Matt. 5:3) and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; (Ps 37:11, Matt 5:5) and **he shall strike the earth with the rod of his mouth**,
- and with the breath of his lips he shall kill the wicked. (Luke 2:34,35) (Ps. 2:9, Rev 2:27, 12:519:15, Is 49:6, Heb 4:12)
- ⁵ **Righteousness** shall be the belt of his waist, and **faithfulness** the belt of his loins. (Eph. 6:14)
- ⁶ The wolf shall dwell with the lamb, (Is. 65:25) and the leopard shall lie down with the young goat, and the calf and the lion and the fattened calf together; and a little child shall lead them.
- ⁷ The cow and the bear shall graze; their young shall lie down together; and the lion shall eat straw like the ox.
- ⁸ The nursing child shall play over the hole of the cobra, and the weaned child shall put his hand on the adder's den.
- ⁹They shall not hurt or destroy in all my holy mountain;
- for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD (ISAIAH 6:3) as the waters cover the sea.
- ¹⁰ In that day the root of Jesse, who shall stand as a signal for the peoples (John 8:28, 12:32)—of him shall the nations inquire, and **his resting place shall be glorious.** (Romans 15:12)
