John 9:13-41

¹⁵ So the Pharisees again asked him how he had received his sight. And he said to them, **“He put mud on my eyes, and I washed, and I see.”**...

²⁴ So for the second time they called the man who had been blind and said to him, “Give glory to God. We know that this man is a sinner.”

²⁵ He answered, **“Whether he is a sinner I do not know. One thing I do know, that though I was blind, now I see.”** (Isaiah 35:5)

²⁶ They said to him, “What did he do to you? How did he open your eyes?” ²⁷ He answered them, **“I have told you already, and you would not listen.** Why do you want to hear it again? Do you also want to become his disciples?” ²⁸ And they reviled him, saying, “You are his disciple, but we are disciples of Moses. ²⁹ We know that God has spoken to Moses, but as for this man, we do not know where he comes from.”

³⁰ The man answered, **“Why, this is an amazing thing! You do not know where he comes from, and yet he opened my eyes.** ³¹ We know that God does not listen to sinners, but if anyone is a worshiper of God and does his will, God listens to him. ³² Never since the world began has it been heard that anyone opened the eyes of a man born blind. ³³ If this man were not from God, he could do nothing.”

³⁴ They answered him, **“You were born in utter sin, and would you teach us?”** And they cast him out.

³⁵ Jesus heard that they had cast him out, and having found him he said, “Do you believe in the **Son of Man?**”

³⁶ He answered, “And who is he, sir, that I may believe in him?”

³⁷ Jesus said to him, “You have seen him, and it is he who is speaking to you.” ³⁸ He said, **“Lord, I believe,”** and he worshiped him.

³⁹ Jesus said, “For judgment I came into this world, that those who do not see may see, and those who see may become blind.”(Isaiah 6:8-13) ⁴⁰ Some of the Pharisees near him heard these things, and said to him, “Are we also blind?” ⁴¹ Jesus said to them, “If you were blind, you would have no guilt; but now that you say, ‘We see,’ your guilt remains.
