¹⁴**I have said all these things to you to keep you from falling away...**⁷ Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: **it is to your advantage that I go away**, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you.

¹⁶ “A little while, & you will see me no longer; & again a little while, & you will see me.” ¹⁷ So some of his disciples said to one another, “What is this that he says to us, ‘A little while, & you will not see me, & again a little while, & you will see me’; &, ‘because I am going to the Father’?” ¹⁸ So they were saying, “What does he mean by ‘a little while’? We do not know what he is talking about.”

¹⁹ Jesus knew that they wanted to ask him, so he said to them, “Is this what you are asking yourselves, what I meant by saying, ‘A little while & you will not see me, & again a little while & you will see me’?” ²⁰ Truly, truly, I say to you, you will *weep & lament*, but the world will **rejoice**. You will be sorrowful, **but your sorrow will turn into joy**.

²¹ **When a woman is giving birth**, she has *sorrow* because her hour has come, but when she has delivered the baby, she no longer remembers the *anguish*, for **joy** that a human being has been born into the world. ²² So also you have *sorrow* now, but I will see you again, & your hearts will **rejoice**, & no one will take your **joy** from you. ²³ In that day you will ask nothing of me. Truly, truly, I say to you, whatever you ask of the Father in my name, he will give it to you. ²⁴ Until now you have asked nothing in my name. Ask, & you will receive, that your **joy** may be full.

²⁵ “I have said these things to you in figures of speech. The hour is coming when I will no longer speak to you in figures of speech but will tell you plainly about the Father. ²⁶ In that day you will ask in my name, & I do not say to you that I will ask the Father on your behalf; ²⁷ **for the Father himself loves you, because you have loved me & have believed that I came from God**. ²⁸ I came from the Father & have come into the world, & now I am leaving the world & going to the Father.”

²⁹ His disciples said, “Ah, now you are speaking plainly & not using figurative speech! ³⁰ Now we know that you know all things & do not need anyone to question you; this is why we believe that you came from God.”

³¹ Jesus answered them, “**Do you now believe?**” ³² Behold, the hour is coming, indeed it has come, when you will be scattered, each to his own home, & will leave me alone. Yet I am not alone, for the Father is with me. ³³ I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. **But take heart; I have overcome the world.**”
